WHO WAS RONALD TAKAKI?

RONALD TAKAKI WAS A DISTINGUISHED HISTORIAN AND PROFESSOR AT THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, BERKELEY. ITS EMPHASIS ON DIVERSITY, INCLUSION, AND CRITICAL ANALYSIS MAKES IT AN INDISPENSABLE RESOURCE FOR THOSE SEEKING TO GRASP THE RICH, AND OFTEN COMPLICATED, TAPESTRY OF THE UNITED STATES. AS AMERICA GRAPPLES WITH QUESTIONS OF IDENTITY AND BELONGING, TAKAKI'S WORK OFFERS A VITAL LENS THROUGH WHICH THE NATION'S PAST AND PRESENT CAN BE VIEWED WITH GREATER CLARITY AND EMPATHY.

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
