- **SYNTHETIC FIBERS:** MAN-MADE FIBERS SUCH AS NYLON, POLYESTER, AND ACRYLIC.

ANSWERS DISCUSSING THESE TECHNIQUES UNDERScore THEIR SIGNIFICANCE IN PROVIDING CONFIRMATORY EVIDENCE BEYOND VISUAL INSPECTION.

FIBER CONTAMINATION AND TRANSFER

FIBER EVIDENCE CAN BE EASILY TRANSFERRED OR CONTAMINATED, COMPLICATING FORENSIC CONCLUSIONS. ACCURATE WORKSHEET ANSWERS EMPHASIZE THE NEED FOR CONTEXT, CHAIN OF CUSTODY, AND CORROBORATIVE EVIDENCE WHEN EVALUATING FIBER TRACES.
